Certificate of Advanced Studies (CAS) in Higher Education

The certificate addresses six main subject areas:

- Planning and development of course offerings
- Instructional methods
- Advising students
- Evaluating students
- Quality assurance for instructors and curricula
- Self-management and professionalism in the higher education setting

Those who enrol for 18 full days of instruction and complete the supplementary assignments may receive a CAS worth 15 European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS) credit points.

The certificate programme's flexible structure permits part-time study. Registration is on an ongoing basis. Participants design their own programmes with a combination of electives that best match their own needs and interests. Transfer groups facilitate the sharing of practical knowledge, and project groups cooperate on model curricula. The CAS certificate includes documentation of the participant's theory-practice transfer project.

Consulting for individuals / teams / groups

Teaching is not always amenable to standardization. Instruction methods vary according to the learning situation, the topic to be communicated, the audience to be addressed, and the personalities involved. Answers to individual questions can be hard to deliver adequately in a group setting. To meet specific needs, the Educational Development Unit also offers personalized academic development consulting. Our consulting service allows our know-how to take effect where it is needed – whether in the lecture hall or in individual meetings with students.

The Educational Development Unit offers project consultation for working groups developing curricula or optimizing their course offerings.
