

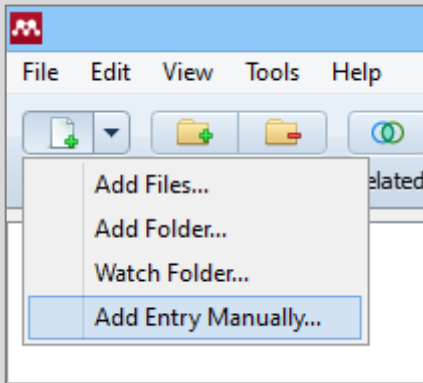

5. Import via DOI oder aus anderen Literaturmanagementsystemen (Endnote, Citavi, Zotero, etc.)

→ *Keine Nachkorrekturen, spart viel Zeit*

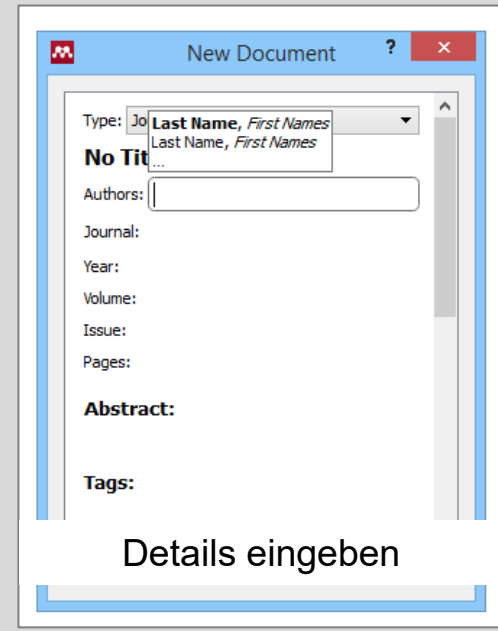
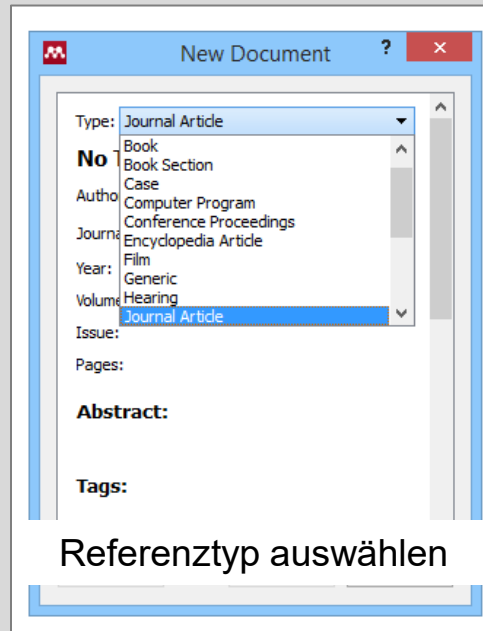

- ✓ Eingaben nicht formatieren, keine Abkürzungen, Satz- & Sonderzeichen verwenden
- ✓ Für Internet-basierte Referenzen: Angabe von DOI (digital object identifier) und URL lohnenswert für schnelles Wiederauffinden.

3. Web Importer: Literaturdatenbanken

Vorgehen

1. Suche Artikel in einer Online-Literaturdatenbank
2. Öffne die Seite mit dem Volltext (via SFX oder Verlag)
3. Verwende den Web Importer
4. Wähle einen Zielordner aus
5. Speichere Referenz ("Save ")
6. Daten importiert in Web-Version
7. Kontrolliere / synchronisiere



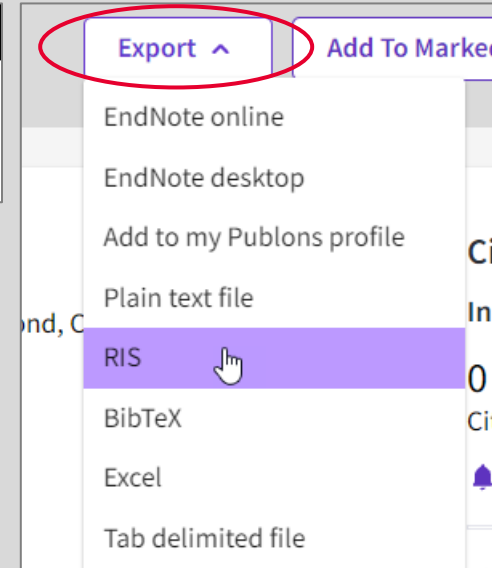
