
Regulations for badge access CAF

Regulations CAF access

1. The undersigned person carrying out the experiment has taken note of the following documents and hereby agrees to their content. They undertake to strictly observe them when working in the Central Animal Facilities.

- SOP Euthanasia CAF
- SOP BSL-2- CAF (only for researcher working in BSL-2 conditions)
- Regulations and User Agreement CAF

The signature of the document '**Application CAF Access Card**' shall also constitute a confidentiality agreement.

2. The persons carrying out the experiments with a CAF admission card are responsible for attending the three mandatory introductions (practical introduction to the animal husbandry, theoretical introduction to processes and Pyrat) **before** receiving the CAF admission card.
3. Users may only enter animal rooms and laboratories of the Central Animal Facilities they have been granted access to. It is not permitted to grant entry to people lacking the authorization to enter the CAF. The CAF access is granted via the Uni Badge or the authorization for external visitors (see "Guidelines for visiting the Central Animal Facilities"). The badge is non-transferable. The owner bears full responsibility over the badge. It is prohibited to lend the badge to other people, regardless of whether or not they are authorized to access the facilities.
4. In case of non-compliance to the regulations, the CAF access can be revoked by the head of the facility.
5. People with access to the CAF need to inform the CAF administrative personnel if they no longer require access to the facilities (e.g. end of experiment, termination of contract)
