



1. Create an Opencast series

First log in to https://opencast.unibe.ch/ with your edu-ID. If you do not yet have access rights, you can apply for them using the form that appears after the login attempt.




 Switch to the «Series» tab and click on «Add series».



- ② Enter the title of the series and further information if required.
- (3) Then click on «Next».

Set access rights (for Tobira) & grant editing rights:



Specify under «Templates», who can access the series and the associated videos on the "Tobira" video platform. All options allow the series to be integrated into ILIAS. The following options are available:

· Tobira: Öffentlich

The series is freely accessible and can be viewed by anyone.

Tobira: Federation

Only members of a Swiss university (SWITCHaai login) can access the series.

• Tobira: Organisation (nurUniBe)

Only members of the University of Bern can access the series.


Tobira: Privat

Only authorized users (see table directly below) can access the series.




- (5) If you would like to allow other people to edit the series, click «New user».
- 6 Search for them using their e-mail address. IMPORTANT: Leave the checkbox activated in the "Write" column.
- (7) Click on «Next».

Add opening credits & create series:




- If you would like to insert an intro or title image with metadata in your videos, select the corresponding template via "No theme".
- Olick on "Next".




Click on «Create» in the «Summary» tab. The series will now be created and you will be taken to the "Series" overview page.

2. Upload videos to Opencast


First log in to https://opencast.unibe.ch/ with your edu-ID. If you do not yet have access rights, you can apply for them using the form that appears after the login attempt.




 Switch to the «Events» tab and click on "Add event".




- ② Enter the title of the video and further information if required.
- 3 Select the series to which the video is to be uploaded.
- 4 Click on «Next».





- 4 Click «Choose file» and select the video you want to upload on your computer. Consider: Use the button for slides if you want the text in your video to be recognized and then searchable by viewers.
- ⑤ If you want to upload already existing subtitles, your files need to be in the format «VTT». Consider: Subtitles can also be created automatically using Opencast (see below).
- 6 Click on «Next».

- Activate the checkbox «Publish automatically» if the video should be published directly after uploading. Otherwise it will only be uploaded and you will have to publish it later (or edit and publish).
- 8 Activate the checkbox «Generate subtitles» if you want subtitles to be generated.
- 9 Click on «Next».




Switch to the «Summary» tab and click on «Create». Only then will the video be uploaded and you will be taken to the «Video» overview page.




Depending on the file size and your upload speed, the upload may take a few minutes. This is indicated by a green status indicator (at the bottom right of the browser window).

Once the video has been uploaded, it is displayed in the table and is initially in the status "Processing". After a maximum of one hour, the video is fully processed (status "Finished").



3. Tobira link to series

First log in to https://opencast.unibe.ch/ with your edu-ID. If you do not yet have access rights, you can apply for them using the form that appears after the login attempt.




 Click on the three green bars next to your series or next to a video of this series. This opens the series details.




② Switch to the «Tobira» tab. Click on the copy icon next to «Direct link to series» to copy the direct link to the series.

4. Edit existing series

First log in to https://opencast.unibe.ch/ with your edu-ID. If you do not yet have access rights, you can apply for them using the form that appears after the login attempt.



 Click on the three green bars next to your series or next to a video of this series.
 This opens the series details.




You can change different things in the offered tabs:


- ② Metadata: Change title etc.
- 3 Access Policy: Add/delete access restrictions to Tobira and authorised persons.
- **Theme**: Change intro (requires a republication of all already published videos).

5. Edit existing videos

You can rename, cut, publish, withdraw and delete existing videos and change their metadata. You can access most of these actions via the icons in the «Actions» column (far right). For some actions, you must select the video and click on the «Actions» button (see next page).




Edit metadata, delete and cut videos



Publish directly, create (and publish) subtitles, copy, withdraw publication

Select the desired video (via checkbox), click on "Actions" then on 'Start Task' and then «Next». Select the desired workflow and click «Next» again. Only when you click on «Create» you start the work step definitively.

The following actions are available:

- Publish with subtitles: Publishes the video including any subtitles.
- Publish without subtitles: Publishes the video without any subtitles.
- **Generate subtitles:** Creates subtitles and publishes the video if desired (see option offered).
- Duplicate Event: Creates copies of the video. You can specify the title, number of copies and, if required, a target series.
- **Retract:** Withdraws the publication. Students will then not be able to view the video via ILIAS or Tobira.
- Republish metadata: This is necessary if you want to change video metadata and if these changes should affect Tobira.

6. Trim and edit videos (e.g. subtitles, tracks)






To open the video editor, click the «Scissors» icon next to the desired video.

- The audio waves in the time track of the video make it easier to find segments with or without sound.
- Use the «Zoom» function to zoom into the time track and edit the video more precisely.
- To cut, drag the cursor to the desired position.
- Use the "Cut" button to divide the recording into segments.
- ⑤ Use the «Delete» button to mark the segments that should not be published. They are now highlighted in red because they are still awailable but will not appear in the published recording. If the cursor is in a red segment, the button changes to «Restore» and you can restore the segment.
- 6 Deactivate the «Preview Mode» if you want to watch the red segments too.
- (7) If required, you can use the navigation on the left to edit the metadata, tracks, subtitles, and the video's preview image.
- The «Finish» button gives you the option of publishing the edited video («Save and process changes») or «Save changes». You will be asked whether you would like to «Publish the video with or without subtitles».

Edit tracks

If you want to remove an video or audio track from your video (e.g. for dual-stream recordings or to publish only audio), switch to the «Tracks» section.




- 1) First activate the «Customize track selection» option.
- 2 You can now activate/deactivate the desired video or audio tracks by clicking the corresponding checkbox.

Add or edit subtitles

In the «Subtitles» section, you can edit the existing subtitles (e.g. the automatically generated ones), create your own subtitles or upload them. You can find out how to publish a video without subtitles on page 12, step 8.




- 1 If your video already has subtitles, you can edit them by clicking on the corresponding tile.
- ② Click on the + sign if you want to add or upload new subtitles. First select one of the supported languages.

In both cases, the subtitle editor will open (see left).

- 3 You can upload new subtitles and download existing subtitles.
- 4 You can use the + sign to add a new segment before or after an existing subtitle segment.
- 5 Here you can enter or edit the text. If you click in one of the boxes, the video jumps to the corresponding position.
- 6 You can change the time and duration of the subtitle segments via the input fields or via the subtitle track. In the track, you can move, shorten or lengthen the segments by dragging at the beginning and end.

Select or upload thumbnail

In the «Thumbnail» section, you can generate a preview image from your video or upload your own image.



- If you want to select an image as thumbnail from the video, position the cursor at the desired location and click «Generate».
- ② Alternatively, you can also upload your own thumbnail via «Upload». It should be in 16:9 format, if possible.
