 $oldsymbol{u}^{\scriptscriptstyle b}$ Visa or permit?

visa ≠ residence permit

Visa = Entry to Switzerland

Do I need a visa? Find out here: Online visa system (swiss-visa.ch)

Residence permit = permit to live in Switzerland > apply and register after arrival to Switzerland

u^b Residence PermitRegistration is mandatory

Everyone who lives or works in Switzerland must apply for a Swiss residence permit within the first 8-14 days after arrival.

One must register at the place of residence, e.g.

- Bern > registration Alien Police Bern
- Bolligen > registration cantonal authorities

Most of you have applied for a visa and hence have already submitted the necessary documents e.g. financial statement.

Attachments (copies/scans):

- Entry authorization («Ermächtigung zur Einreise»)
- Passport + visa
- Marriage certificate (if married/registered partnership)
- Rental contract when in sublease a confirmation from the landlord or property management is required



u^b Frequently asked question What is the «AHV number»?

- AHV-Nummer (Swiss social security number / old people's pension)
- Leave blank if you do not know the number or if you do not have such a number
- PhD students may inquire with their employing institutes




u^b Residence permitFees

EU / EFTA nationals:

approx. 96 CHF

Non- EU/EFTA nationals:

approx. 150-250 CHF





u^b Initial Interview for Foreigners Integration

Local authorities will invite non-EU/EFTA nationals for an initial interview and discuss integration issues, e.g. learning German.

- Attendance is mandatory upon invitation.
- Mainly concerns PhDs and postdocs with families.
